A redevelopment of a 59,920sqm warehouse for XPO Supply Chain UK. The site is split into three bays. The middle unit was developed and raised its eves to reach the adjoining units.4,645sqm of Grade A warehouse space to meet the incoming tenant's requirements.

Harniss worked on an all-new building services specification associated with this development to ensure excellent lighting, and thermal comfort for its occupants were provided.

The scheme achieved BREEAM NC 2014 'Very Good' and a 'A' rated EPC to ensure planning compliance.


This was achieved with a combination of low air permeability, good use of natural daylight and low energy lighting with automatic sensor controls throughout.
