Further works included investigating the merits of new gas fired Combined Heat and Power (CHP's) systems, Biomass, Air Source Heat Pumps (ASHP), Photovoltaic solar panel arrays and replacement lighting upgrades to low energy fittings with sensor controls.

All contributing to the programmed planning for future energy conservation and to meet their year-on-year reduction commitments.
